NEBOSH Resources

If you are studying for a NEBOSH qualification, we would like to remind you that guidance from NEBOSH is available in the following publications, which can all be accessed from the 'Learners' area of the NEBOSH website (under 'Resources' for each qualification):

- **Preparing Learners for Assessment - Certificate and Diploma Written Question Papers**

This gives advice on learning methods, revision and examination technique and is designed to boost your confidence and improve your performance in the written assessment.

- **Guidance on Command Words – Certificate Qualifications**

This gives definitions of command words and example responses to everyday scenarios and typical exam questions.

- **Guidance on Command Words – Diploma Qualifications**

This gives definitions of command words and example responses to typical exam questions.

We strongly recommend reading this guidance as part of your preparation for the exams.

Sample new-look question papers for each **NEBOSH Certificate** qualification are also available in the 'Learners' area of the NEBOSH website (under 'Resources' for each qualification). RRC Health and Safety Law and Case Law Guide

We have updated the Health and Safety Law and Case Law Guide in relation to some recent legislation. If you are studying a national (UK) course, please note the changes below.

Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment Regulations 2009

In this entry, at the end of the subsection on Part 4, the following new text has been added:

“An amendment to the original Regulations added requirements for tanks for the storage of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs).”

The headings for **Part 5** and **Regulation 24** have been changed to “Radiation Emergencies and Notifiable Events”.

Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2012

In this entry, under the subheading **Introduction**, the following new text has been added:

“Changes were made to the Regulations by the **Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (Amendment) Regulations 2019** which removed restrictions on the supply of second-hand equipment, spare parts and the sale of new organ pipes that would have come within the scope of the Regulations in 2019.”

In this entry, at the end of the subsection on Part 4, the following new text has been added:

“An amendment to the original Regulations added requirements for tanks for the storage of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs).”

The headings for **Part 5** and **Regulation 24** have been changed to “Radiation Emergencies and Notifiable Events”.

Climate Change Act 2008

In this entry, in the subsection on **Part 1, Sections 1 to 3**, the first paragraph has been amended to read:

“The Secretary of State must ensure that the net UK carbon account for the year 2050 is at least 100% lower than the 1990 baseline. (1990 net UK CO₂ and other targeted greenhouse gas emissions for that year.) The original target was 80% but that was increased to 100% by the **Climate Change Act 2008 (2050 Target Amendment) Order 2019** in June 2019.”

Some text in this element has been updated in relation to ISO 14005:2019.

In the subsection entitled **THE LATEST DEVELOPMENTS WITH THE ISO 14000 SERIES AND EMAS**, the third paragraph now reads as follows:

“**ISO 14005** has also been developed, which covers the phased implementation of environmental management systems. This Standard covers an approach where an organisation can gain credit for implementing a smaller EMS than required by **ISO 14001**, but build a system that is compatible with **ISO 14001** over time. Other standards in the series include:”
